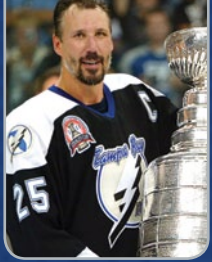

A two-time NHL All-Star and original member of the Lightning, Brian spent the final six years of a 14-year career in Tampa Bay. In the 10 years since Brian's retirement from the game, he has spent countless hours running high-tempo hockey clinics while helping to develop youth hockey in the Tampa Bay metro area. A father of two boys in the Florida Youth Hockey System, Brian served as the head coach for the '96 AAA team and has coached at national tournaments including Nationals, Bell Capital Cup and Pee-Wee Quebec.

Dave Andreychuk, Camp Instructor



Dave Andreychuk led the Lightning to the 2004 Stanley Cup Championship and returns as Camp Instructor. Dave was signed by the Lightning in 2001 and played for five seasons. He is the NHL's all-time leader in power play goals with 274, ranks fourth all-time with 1,639 games played and is 26th in points with 1,332.

Dave is passionate about sharing his love of the game with the younger generation and is thrilled to be coaching youngsters and teens in the Tampa Bay Lightning Summer Hockey Camp.

Nigel Kirwan, Video Coach



For 13 seasons, Nigel Kirwan has been responsible for the breakdown of pre-scout and game film as well as creating highlight and specialty film for the Lightning. He has coached amateur hockey in Canada and the U.S. for 17 years and served as Video Coach for Team USA at the 2008 and 2009 World Championships.
